This space was previously used as an office and the client demanded to complete renovation and transformation into an apartment. The kitchen was removed and a new bathroom built. New openings were added and existing ones closed in order to redefine the residential space. Existing niches were used for storage, thus allowing optimal use of the available space. The height of the rooms and the absence of doors, together with the chosen colors work together to create a 'hall' or 'gallery' atmosphere. The walls, floors, ceilings are all white. In order to create a contrast, a dark material was chosen for the work surface in the kitchen. The client's belongings add further color contrast and dynamic accents.
